#### THE DEATH OF ALEXANDER THE GREAT

An unexpected development took place in reference to the goat. The great horn between his eyes was broken just when the goat had reached the pinnacle of his strength. Out of this grew four horns described as being "toward the four winds of heaven." Expositors, both liberal and conservative, have interpreted this verse as representing the untimely death of Alexander and the division of his empire into four major sections.25 Although Alexander conquered more of the world than any previous ruler, he was not able to conquer himself.

Partly due to a strenuous exertion, his dissipated life, and a raging fever, Alexander died in a drunken debauch at Babylon, not yet thirty-three years of age. His death left a great conquest without an effective single leader, and it took twenty years for the empire to be successfully divided.

Practically all commentators recognize the four horns as symbolic of the four kingdoms of the Diadochi which emerged as follows: (1) Cassander assumed rule over Macedonia and Greece; (2) Lysimachus took control of Thrace, Bithynia, and most of Asia Minor; (3) Seleucus took Syria and the lands to the east including Babylonia; (4) Ptolemy established rule over Egypt and possibly Palestine and Arabia Petraea. A fifth contender for political power, Antigonus, was soon defeated. With remarkable accuracy Daniel predicted that Alexander's empire would be divided into four sections.
